

Grade 10 Required Courses (6 mandatory credits):

Math 10* (choose one)

Math Essentials 20S

Introduction to Applied/Pre-Calculus Math 20S

One of these is required for the Math credit for grade 10. Successful completion of this course is required for students before they can take any grade 11 math course(s). The math class you choose in grade 10 can affect the choice you have for math in grade 11 and 12. English Language Arts 20S*

Also known as ELA, English Language Arts takes a look at various texts of literature and various strategies for reading and writing.

Religious Studies 21G: The New Testament in its World*

The aim of this course is to focus on the Greek (New) Testament and its impact on the lives of students. In order to understand the role of the Christian according to a biblical framework, one needs to deeply study the life of Jesus' work to imitate his actions and life in the various contexts in which we find ourselves.

Physical Education/Health 20F*

This course involves physical activity in the gym as well as healthy lifestyle education in the classroom.

Social Studies 20F* (Geographic Issues of the 21st Century)

Science 20S*
